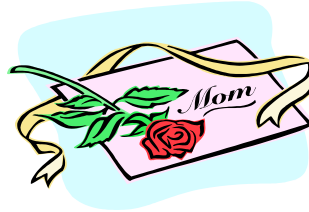


### Retirements

Several dedicated staff members have indicated their intent to retire at the end of this school year. We are aware of a couple of receptions that are planned and staff are welcome.



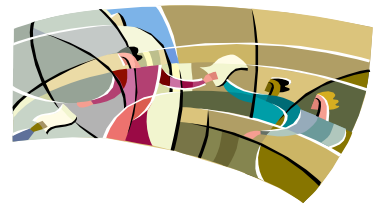

### Oregon High School of the Arts Charter School

At the last School Board Meeting, the Board denied the Oregon High School of the Arts Charter School.



The Board will now issue a summary document outlining why they are denying the application and what possible remedies would make the application acceptable. The charter school applicants have the option of working with the school board to achieve those remedies or applying to the Oregon Department of Education for independent sponsorship. They could also drop their pursuit of the application.
