**North Bend School District #13
Regular Board Meeting
September 11, 2006**

The North Bend School District Board of Directors held their Regular Board Meeting at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, September 11, 2006 at the North Bend City Council Chambers, 835 California Street, North Bend, Oregon.

- Moment of Silence was held for those who lost their lives on 9-11-01
- Newly appointed Board Member, Rhonda Cuzzort was administered the Oath of Office.
- Oath of Office was administered to our 2006-2007 Student Board Advisors, Sara Marroqun and Chase Cribbins.
- Drama Director, Terri Bond reported that another drama class was added to the curriculum this year due to the large number of students who will be involved drama this year. Terri told the audience that there will be three play productions this year.
- ORCO Tech teacher, Barbara Becker, presented a power point on WriteSite. Barb stated that the district is focusing on increasing writing skills and has contracted with Nick Viani and "WriteSite" to provide Six Trait Writing Model professional development for grades 5-8 teachers at the middle school and ORCO Tech. Four elementary teachers are also participating in this professional development at the middle school. Nick will visit the middle school and work with the staff in improving our writing instruction on five different occasions during the school year.
- **Communication:**

 - Board members wishing to attend the 2006 Annual Convention in Portland are to turn in their registration/motel information to Barb Reese no later than September 15, 2006.
 - A plaque for the dedication and services for past Board Member, Dennis Turowski, was presented.
 - September 27th is the Community Service Involvement day (CSI) for high school students. If anyone would like to participate or help with the event, they are to contact the high school.
 - Superintendent Hollensteiner reported that the start of school had a "smooth beginning" and that enrollment numbers will be available soon.
 - Superintendent Hollensteiner reported that North Bay Elementary had a break-in last weekend. Gold Coast Security has completed their security project at the high school and that all motion sensors are in operation.
 - Hospice has responded to our request to pay for half of the cost for resealing the District Office Parking lot and signage. A bid was received from Pro-Tech in the amount of \$2,490 for the resealing and stripping of the District Office parking lot. . Hospice is working on the lighting issue for the parking lot and they agreed that the District would pay a lesser percentage of the cost due to the fact that Hospice is open later in the evening. An additional electrical pole may need to be added for better lighting.

- Curriculum and Instruction Director, Jim Moyer reported that two teachers (Forensics Director, Josh Schierman and Science teacher, Bob Estill) would be able to offer college credits to their students' this year. Mr. Schierman worked with Southern Oregon University and will be able to offer a Communication credit. The college speech credit is for students who take forensics in their junior and senior year and complete certain projects. Students, who take the physics class with Mr. Estill, will be able to earn a general science credit from Southwestern Oregon Community College.
